

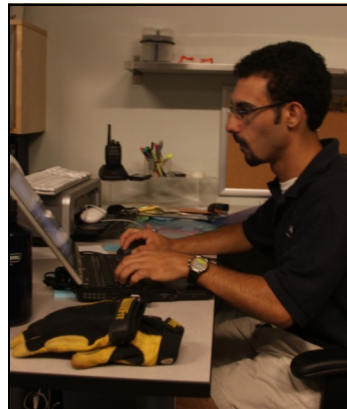
Volunteers

- Be at least 16 years of age
- 1 year commitment
- Schedule up to volunteer & Aquarium needs
- At least 100 hours per year to waive Membership fee next year
- Can work in several departments
- Earn tickets & passes
- Application process: Apply online, attend Info Session, complete background check & pay Volunteer Membership fee
- Be able to show proof of eligibility to work in the United States



Interns

- Be at least 18 years of age
- 3 to 8 month commitment
- Regular schedule
- At least 20 hours per week
- Only works in 1 department
- Only get Aquarium discounts until completion of internship. At completion, if intern returns ID & has at least 100 hours, he/she receives 5 Aquarium tickets
- Application process: Apply online & email resume to department supervisor listed on website.
- Only selected applicants will be contacted for interview & background check
- Can earn school credit
- Be able to show proof of eligibility to work in the United States
- Be able to pass a background check



Youth

- Be 14 or 15 years of age by start of program
- 4 month commitment (Summer, Spring, Fall Sessions available)
- Schedule up to the volunteer & Teen Volunteer Coordinator
- 112 hours each session Volunteer as greeter, mascot assistant, at conservation carts, and as a Camp H2O helper
- Only get Aquarium discounts until end of program. At completion, receives 5 tickets for full participation.
- Application process: Application made available 3 times a year, apply by deadline, selected candidates must attend info. session with parent & pay \$30 Volunteer Membership fee, attend day of training
- Be able to provide copy of birth certificate and government or school issued photo id
