Age Groups & Themes

Children are grouped together based on their grade and each group will have a theme they will focus on for the week. Children must be placed according to the grade grouping as listed below (and based on availability). We are unable to accommodate children under the age of 5.

Rising 1st & 2nd grades – Animal Adventures

Through life-size learning, campers will discover various habitats from rivers to the ocean. Up close encounters with the watery world will help campers learn how coverings and colors help animals survive.

Rising 3rd & 4th grades – Where in the World is Deepo?

Travel the aquarium with Deepo learning about some of the interesting adaptation our animals have and the unique environment in which they live. Campers with the help of their travel scrapbook will document their new discoveries.

Rising 5th & 6th grades – Junior Biologists

Ever wonder what it is like to care for aquatic animals? Come with us behind the scenes to observe how we test the water, prepare the food, and train the animals. Campers will meet some of our staff and learn about the diverse careers at the aquarium.
